Thank you for your participation in year one of the Student Leadership Johns Creek program. This letter is to inform you of your involvement in year two (2) of the Student Leadership Johns Creek program.

As a member of the Student Leadership Class of 2025, I agree to abide by the following standards:

- Devote time and energy to developing my leadership skills. Recognize that SLJC is a highly competitive program and you have been selected to be an enthusiastic and committed participant. Program dates and two 2nd-year projects are **requirements of Student Leadership Johns Creek, and time management is critical.**
- The success of the Student Leadership Johns Creek depends on the **full commitment of each participant** to attend all program sessions, arrive on time, and stay for the entirety of the program.
- It is your responsibility to “clear” your personal calendars on SLJC Program Day dates. If a participant is unable to attend a session (or part thereof) due to *exceptional circumstances*, the SLJC Executive Director/Program Director should be advised by email, text message, or telephone **as soon as the conflict is known**. If an emergency arises **on the day of the session** the SLJC Executive Director/Program Director should be advised by email.
- ***Two unexcused absences or not completing assigned projects (2) on time will result in dismissal from the program.***
- Engage actively and positively in SLJC activities, showing respect for the input, ideas, and creative thinking of class members. ***Active participation is expected of each student in a group project.***
- Communicate actively and in a timely fashion and give candid feedback.
- Adhere to the dress code for scheduled activities and adhere to cell phone guidelines during each session. **Do not wear SLJC t-shirt to any political gatherings.**
- Remain alcohol and drug-free and have no discipline infraction(s) throughout the SLJC program.

I will show respect for myself, my peers, my school, my community leaders, the environments in which we meet, and SLJC. 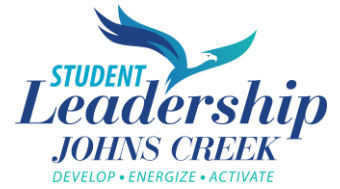

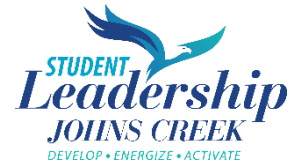
